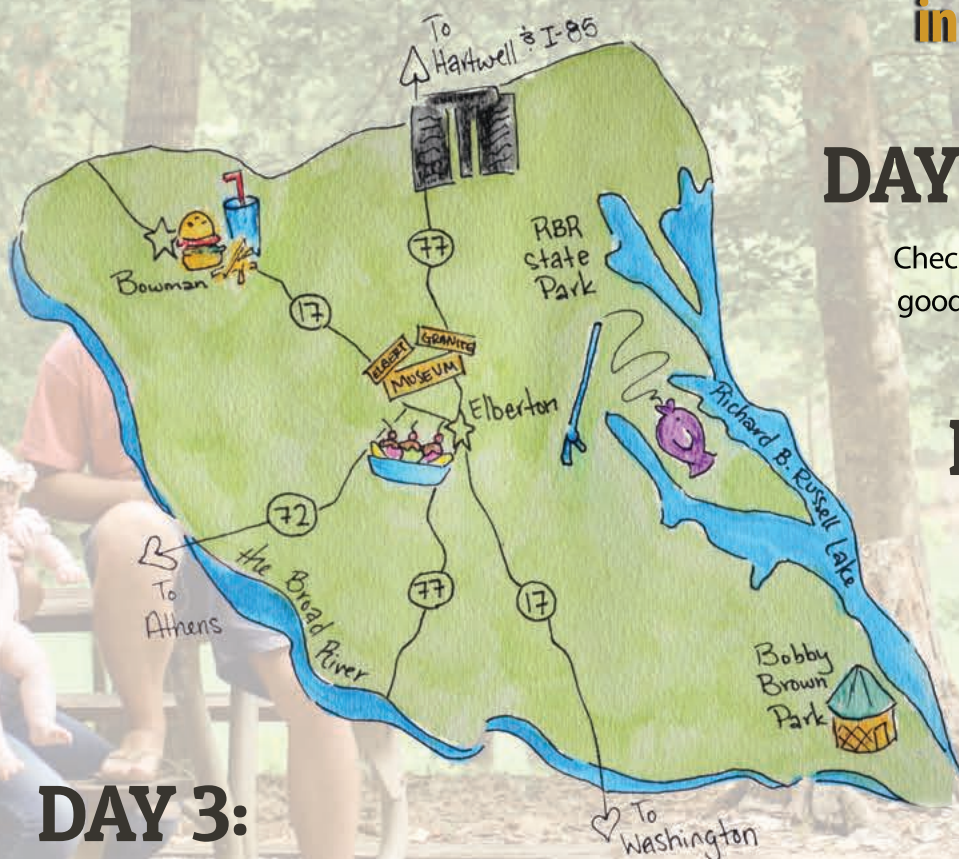


CARVE OUT 48 HOURS with kids in Elbert County, Georgia
